Village & Church News

I am very pleased to inform you all that the government has now agreed to fund the continuation of the Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme which enables church councils to reclaim the VAT incurred in church repairs. This is the last piece of the financial jig-saw puzzle which enables us to fund the repairs to the tower of St Marys church.

The cost of actually doing the repairs has escalated because the work is complicated, sophisticated and hazardous. The work involves rebuilding the buttresses in situ, removing the window, securing the foundations, repairing the masonry and stabilising weak parts of the tower.

With the help of Historic England, National Churches Trust, Wolfson Foundation, Allchurches Trust, Norfolk Churches Trust, local charities and YOUR support, we have raised £385,000!

Latest: At an onsite meeting 26/02/21 with the contractors, architect and structural engineer it was apparent that the buttresses could detach from the tower at any time! This requires the method statement and risk assessment to be reviewed and agreed <u>before any</u> work starts.

There is genuine concern about workers' safety. We must ensure that the risks involved are identified and minimised to an acceptable level.

St Marys church is a Grade 1 listed building and whatever the strength of your religious conviction is, I hope you will be as proud as I am to be able to restore such a beautiful historic building as this, in this little village of ours.

March Recipe 'MOTHERS DAY BRUNCH'

Buck wheat pancakes with mushroom & eggs

Batter

- 90g buckwheat flour
- 90g plain flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 6g dried yeast
- 1 large egg
- 325ml milk
- 225 ml warm water
- Oil for greasing



- 4 large flat mushrooms, sliced
- Butter or oil
- 200g Comte or Gruyere cheese, grated
- 4 eggs
- Flat leaf parsley chopped & black pepper

Method

Begin by making batter.

Combine flours, salt & yeast together.

Whisk egg, milk & water then add to flour mix - stir well together, then cover & leave in a warm place.

Meanwhile fry the mushrooms in butter or oil, until tender.

Then in another frying pan, pour in the batter and heat for 2 minutes. Flip it over and break the eggs into it.

Surround it with the cheese, then scatter with mushrooms.

Season with black pepper & sprinkle with parsley.
