A47 NFWS

As you may be aware there were a number of legal challenges lodged against the decision of the Secretary of State to grant Development Consent orders for the three A47 schemes.

The basis for these challenges were centred around cumulative carbon assessments, local carbon plans, bat licences and the completeness of the briefings given to Ministers.

At the oral hearings the judge, to the surprise of many, granted permission for a substantive hearing next year which will hold up all three schemes including the North Tuddenham—Easton dualling.

RECIPE FOR JANUARY

Cajun Turkey / Chicken Salad with Guacamole (Using up Christmas Left-overs)

Ingredients

2 tablespoons sesame seed

2 tablespoons of ground nut/sunflower oil

Leftover turkey or chicken cut into strips

1 tablespoon Cajun spice

1 large red pepper seeded quartered and sliced

1 120g bag herb salad

1 130g tub of guacamole

200g bag of tortilla chips

Method

Heat a large frying pan or wok, sprinkle in sesame seeds and toss them over a fairly high heat until they are slightly golden. Add the oil to the pan /wok and tip in the turkey pieces, Cajun seasoning and red pepper and stir for about 5 minutes, or less if meat is already cooked.

Divide the herb salad between plates and spoon turkey/ chicken stir-fry over each. Top each serving with a spoonful of guacamole.

Pile tortilla chips on the side.

Serve with a chilled white wine.



A Sense of Wonder

To look up into the sky with a sense of wonder. Just like the magi, the wise men, in the gospel. They also looked up. And then looked forward. And then followed. They discovered something of immeasurable value.
