ABOUT THE CHURCH AND FESTIVAL

In 2019 the tower of North Tuddenham's precious late 14th century St Mary's was in imminent danger of collapse. Historic England and others came to the rescue with funding in the region of £500,000.

To celebrate the renovations and life in our community, a 3-DAY FES-TIVAL will take place in MAY 2022 and village residents, the public and interest groups from around Norfolk will descend on our small rural parish in the heart of Norfolk. The newly repaired tower will be re-dedicated with a SPECIAL SERVICE AND RIBBON-CUTTING CEREMONY.

Also on offer will be dramatic LIVE MUSIC, a FAMILY MOVIE and TALKS ON CHURCH CONSERVATION AND ARCHITECTURE by professionals. Elsewhere in the village there'll be a FOCUS ON FARMING with tours of one of Norfolk's most progressive and diversified farms and GUIDED WALKS ON THE BEAUTIFUL WOODED COMMON, led by experts on flora, fauna and conservation management.

There'll be an **ARTS AND CRAFTS COMPETITION** for children helped by two experienced artists and the **GRAND FINALE PARTY** will include a huge bonfire with music, food and fun.
