Parish Council

Last month we held a very proactive Public Meeting to discuss two important events of impact to our village – the A47 Upgrade and potential future housing development. Whilst this meeting was organised by the Parish Council, it was a meeting for residents and whilst very successfully chaired by Cllr Harding, this was all about stakeholder views. Altogether, including Cllrs and District Cllr Bambridge, 54 people attended the meeting which was a significant turn-out for the village on what was a very rainy night!

In terms of the Local Plan Call for Sites, opinion was verbalised throughout the night, concluding with an informal vote to capture indications of feeling; this initial feedback suggested that there was little appetite for development in the village as per the sites and quantity of housing put forward for consultation.

It was concluded that a second Public Meeting should be called later in the Autumn to consider any updates plus to further explore the option of formulating a Neighbourhood Plan. At the time of writing, North Tuddenham Parish Council is holding an extraordinary Parish Council meeting on 26th September at which next-steps, will be explored. All, of course, are welcome to the forthcoming regular meeting scheduled for 14th November. Watch this space (and Facebook and the Parish Council Website!) for further news as we go forward.

Recipe for OctoberRoasted Ratatouille Chicken

A simple method and lovely Mediterranean flavours and colours make this versatile dish perfect for either a family supper or dinner party.

Ingredients

1 onion cut into wedges; 2 red Peppers seeded and cut into chunks; 1 courgette about 200 grammes cut into chunks; 1 small aubergine about 300 g cut into chunks; 4 tomatoes halved; 4 tablespoons of olive oil plus extra for drizzling; 4 chicken breasts -skin on- about 150g each and a few Rosemary sprigs optional

Takes 50 to 60 minutes and serves 4 people.

Method

Preheat the oven to 200° C or fan oven 180° C Lay all the vegetables and the tomatoes in a shallow roasting tin.

Make sure they have lots of room, as overcrowding will slow down the cooking.

Pour over the olive oil and give the vegetables a good mix round until they are all well coated (hands easiest for this). Nestle the chicken breast on top of the vegetables and tuck in some rosemary sprigs, if you have them.

Season everything with salt and black pepper and drizzle a little olive oil over the chicken. Now roast for about 35 minutes until the vegetables are soft and the chicken is golden. Drizzle with oil before serving.

Answers to September's Teasers:

Explanation

The only day that matches either of the two options is Thursday, and it's option 2. Kent is the liar. Yesterday = **Wednesday**


- Q3. What came first, the chicken or the egg?

New Trial Bus Service for North Tuddenham

We have a new bus service to Dereham, the Konnect No.18 which operates on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

It picks up passengers at **The Lodge, and Mill Rd/Main Road**.

The driver will stop if you hold out your hand to indicate that you wish to use the bus! Konnect advise arriving 5/10 minutes early to await the bus!

The cost is £2 or use your bus pass.

Use it or lose it. If we don't use this service, we will lose it. If used a lot it will help the Parish Council to persuade the Bus Company that there is a need for a more regular service.

The timetable should be read in conjunction with that for the No. 8 school bus which can also be used as a normal service bus.
