RECIPE FOR MAY



Honey cheesecake

Ingredients

225 g. whole wheat biscuits, crushed
125 g. melted butter
one teaspoon of ground allspice
350 g. of cottage cheese
125g. clear honey
2 teaspoonfuls brown sugar
2 eggs
Pinch of salt
2 teaspoons ground cinnamon

Method

Mix the biscuits, butter and allspice together, then press into the bottom and sides of a well- greased 25 cm. flan tin. Chill in the refrigerator for 10 minutes.

Mix all the remaining ingredients, except for the cinnamon, together. Spoon into the biscuit crust and dust with the cinnamon.

Put into the oven preheated to warm 170°C and bake for 40 minutes or until the filling is set.

Serves 6 to 8 people.
