RECIPE FOR DECEMBER

Ginger Pear Trifle.

Ingredients

15 g custard powder; 15 ml sugar; 300 ml fresh milk; 150 g ginger cake, sliced;



410 g canned pears in natural juice/ drained and sliced; 150 ml cider; 150 ml fresh whipping cream and 25 g flaked almonds/toasted.

Method

Blend the custard powder and sugar with a little of the milk.

Bring the remaining milk to the boil and pour onto the custard mixture, stirring well.

Return to the pan, bring to the boil, stirring. Cook for one minute. Leave to cool.

Arrange the ginger cake in a glass serving dish. Cover with the pears and pour over the cider. Pour cooled custard over the trifle and leave to set.

Whip cream until softly stiff. Pipe over the custard and decorate with almonds

Served chilled.


