

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### Introduction

WELBORNE CHURCHYARD is a well cared for last resting place of villagers of the past, it is cared for by members of the congregation and villagers who although they do not attend the Church services on a regular basis care enough for this historic building and its churchyard to want to maintain it for future generations. It is a quiet place to stroll amongst the gravestones or to wander along the recently added path of reflection, where it is hoped visitors will enjoy the peaceful beauty that surrounds our lovely Church.

There is also a newer cemetery next to the Church and grounds where interments take place to this day. It is however the purpose of this booklet to record only the names and inscriptions of the deceased who lie at rest in the old churchyard. It was felt that as the passing of time has taken its toll on a number of headstones causing delamination which is making the reading of the names and inscriptions difficult and in some cases impossible to read, that now was the time to compile a record before further de-lamination makes the task ever more difficult.

Great care was taken when trying to decipher these headstones so as to cause no further damage and cross references at the records office in Norwich took place to try to make sure that the record is as accurate as possible.

The plan of the churchyard has been sectioned into four zones, each colour coded, so as to simplify the task of locating the grave by whomsoever would wish to find the last resting place of a family member. Each grave has been numbered and also included where possible the entry number from the Parish records.

Some of the names revealed on headstones can be found in the book "Welborne A Place Of No Importance" by Joy Esberey and Brenda Baxter and may add further interest. Names such as the Sendalls, Doys, Greens, Porretts and Wallers and of course the Clergy, not lease of all the Barham-Johnsons, can be found within this publication, which is available through the Church.

It is hoped that this record will prove a useful addition to the Church and village information leaflets

#### **NOTES**

The following 3 or 4 monumental inscriptions are located inside The Church. It was the practice at one time to allow interment inside All Saints Church, Welborne. The last burial inside the Church being that of Fuller Waller in 1831. By the time that his wife, Jemima died in 1845, the incumbent at the time, John Barham Johnson, would no longer allow burials inside the Church unless certain criteria were met, i.e. the body must be in a lead lined coffin and be interred in a brick grave. At a prohibitive cost of five guineas, this then stopped and further burials inside the Church. Jemima therefore rests outside in the graveyard.

The information within this booklet *in italics* has been found during our research and may be additional to or possibly another means of determining the resting place of the deceased.

Whilst researching the graves in the Churchyard at Norfolk Registry Office, we came across the records of other deceased villagers recorded as having been buried in the Churchyard at Welborne Although no grave markers remain to indicate where they were interred, we have nevertheless included a list dating from 1699 - 1730, which may be of interest to anyone researching their family tree.


